A new year, new challenges for DOP.

Of course our usual work will continue: adoptions, DOP pharmacy and the Canine Rehabilitation Group will get their hands dirty like always. But we do promise some news for the starting year.

In a few days we'll have two Dutch volunteers. They will be our first international volunteers of the year and both will stay for six weeks, performing the day-to-day tasks at Cantinho da Milu's shelter (cleaning, dog hygiene and dog walking) as well as sociabilization of dogs in need of.

Spring will bring a new Sterilization Project, that will give us the chance to sterilize dozens of cats and dogs in a short period of time. It's our much-needed contribution to the pet overpopulation problem!

DOP pharmacy will be extremely busy this year with the Vaccination Project. They are already in the second phase and pretend to soon move on to the third and final phase. In total over 500 dogs from Cantinho da Milu's shelter will be vaccinated!

DOP Against Leishmaniasis will have new challenges coming up, all thanks to the huge success of this year DOP calendar!

A SMALL STEP FOR THE PORTUGUESE, A GIANT LEAP FOR PETS

Until last December Portuguese Law forbade violence against animals, but there was no indication of sanctions for noncompliance, unless the animal had an "owner" and the owner claimed propriety damages.

This void in the law existed since 1995, the year in which this particular law was approved, and since then no change was done to it.



It took 18 years, but on December 6, 2013 this problem was finally addressed, and it was approved by the Portuguese Parliament a maximum of three years in jail and/or fines that can go up to 5000€ (60k if enterprise). More important than the actual sanctions is that they will be implemented by simple cruelty to a pet, therefore ending the association with a propriety status. Pets gain the right to not suffer any kind of violence, regardless of who practices it.

It was also given to legally established animal charities the opportunity to require authorities and courts the necessary actions to end a running or eminent criminal act against a pet.

Despite this important and necessary step, this law left out some practices, such as bullfighting, animal circuses, hunting and sport fishing.
